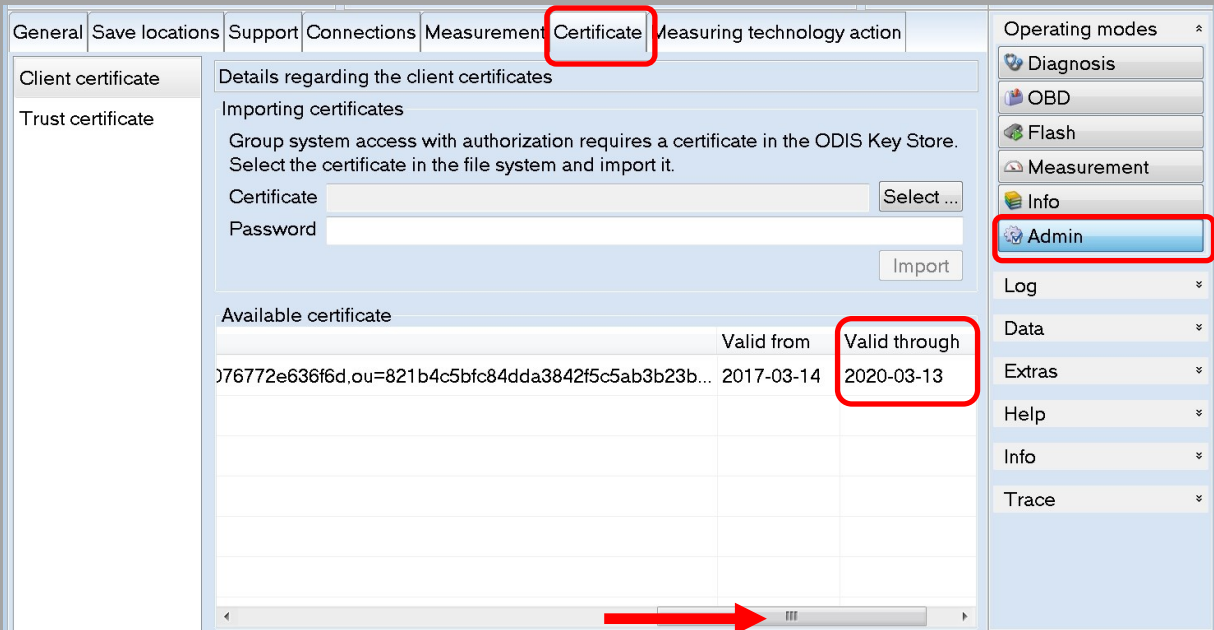

Offboard Diagnostic Information System Service (ODIS Service)

Our Support Team are fielding more calls from users who have let their ODIS Service Certificates expire. An expired certificate results in an interruption in your use of the software.

You can check when your ODIS Service Certificate will expire, and then plan accordingly when to renew it:

1. In ODIS Service, go to **Admin** and select the **Certificate** tab
2. In the **Available certificate** window, scroll to the right and note the **Valid through** date:

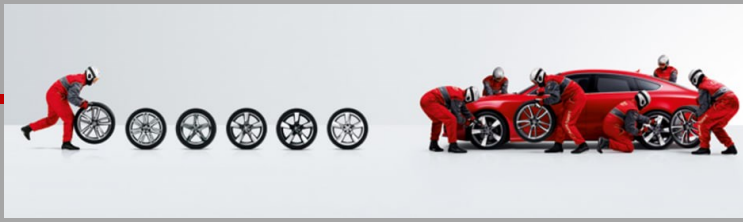


Please remember that certificates are valid for one year.

To renew a certificate about to expire: logon to erWin, select the **Vehicle Diagnostics** category and follow the instructions link in **Step 2**.

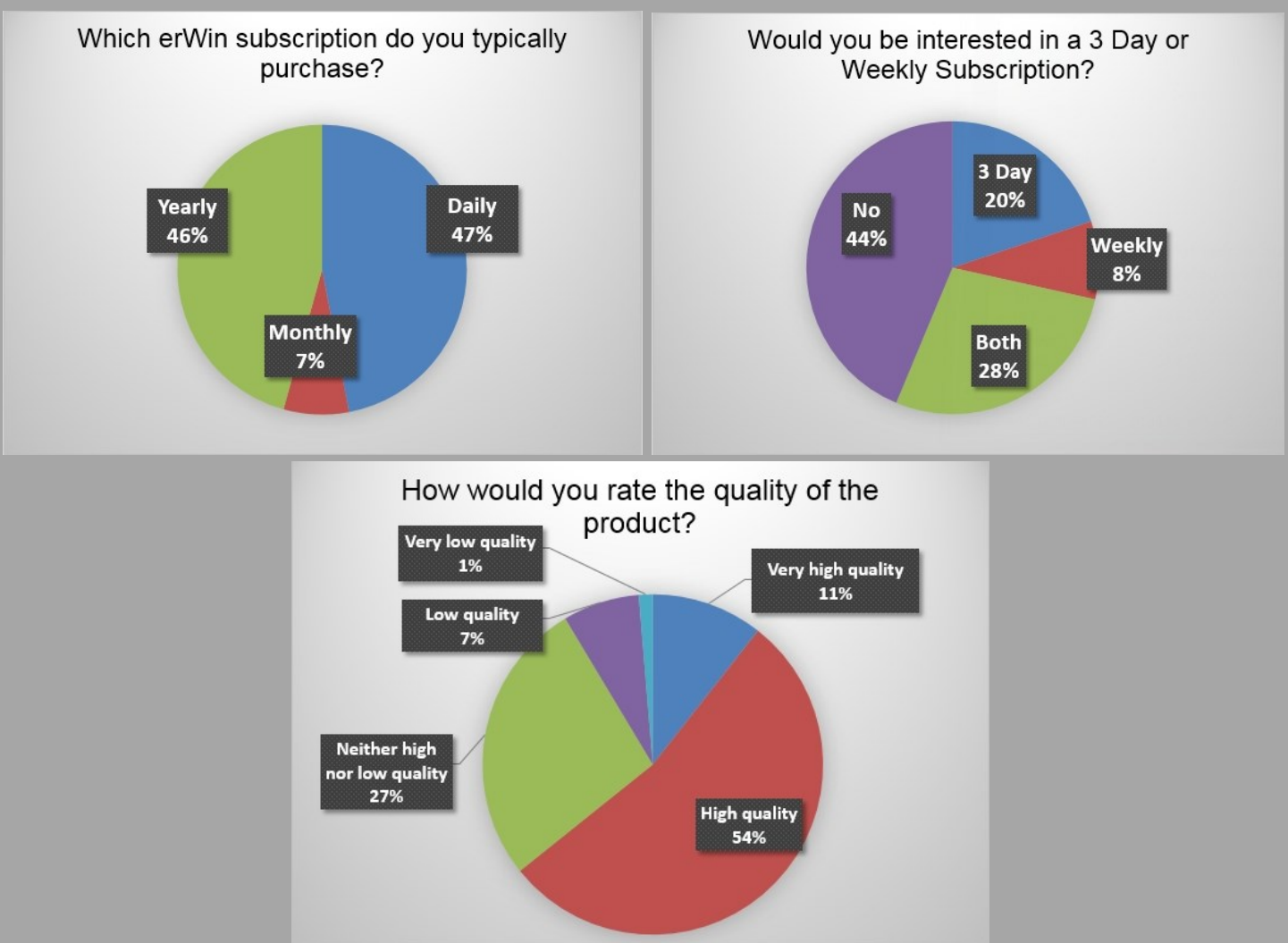
This would also be a good time to check the expiry date of your software license: Go to **Admin** and select the **General** tab. Select the **License** category and note the **valid through** date of the license.

Licenses are valid for two years. Renew them by going to erWin > Vehicle Diagnostics > Step 3
